Such exploitation, whether intentional or unwitting, necessitates repentance and forgiveness. The sacrificial death of Jesus on the cross extends



to all pained children enduring exploitation, underscoring the urgency of prayer and action to protect and uplift them.

Let us frequently pray for these vulnerable children and for ourselves, asking for forgiveness for any role we may have played in perpetuating exploitation. May we strive to be channels of blessing rather than exploiters, committed to safeguarding and nurturing the well-being of children in our midst.
