

Death is real and causes much fear and worry to so many, as many are not sure of their eternity. Jesus' love and sacrifice on the cross conquered death and was precisely to help us overcome this fear. At the garden when the enemy told Eve, they will not die if they eat of that fruit, that assurance gave her the confidence to eat the forbidden fruit. Though they did not physically die, it caused their spiritual death and ultimately their physical death. But God did not create us to die. He created us to live eternally with Him as His children. This truth has been kept away because the enemy of God, the devil, does not want anyone to live and enjoy eternity with him. He deceived Eve and he continues to deceive everyone.

A college friend of mine in our WhatsApp group, whenever sees anyone shares anything about after death, and eternal life, immediately responds by saying 'life ends when you stop breathing. You see how the lie of the enemy has been repeated. He urges all of us to do what pleases us and live. So, for me CROSS stands for 'Christ's Redemptive Offer by Supreme Sacrifice'. The cross is the gift of salvation offered to all mankind through the shedding of his blood.

Sadly, many within the church have not grasped the truth of his love, they are still living blinded and often going after smaller gods and ungods. In Isaiah 58, God expressed his disappointment with His own people, who live just as the ones who do not know God. They exploit, they quarrel, they cheat, they bribe and they expect God to work based on their ritualistic life. But they don't live by the standards of God. God wants to reveal this truth of His supreme sacrifice through our lives, so all will experience His offer of the gift of salvation. This message of the Cross is universal, and the Lord reveals his heart through John 3:16, "For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not die but have eternal life." His love forced him to die for us.

But are we willing to receive this highest offer as our own and make it known to people under the fear of death? Death is conquered by Jesus, and the Joy of eternal life is given to all of us, who believe in His Name and call him as our Father. This will help us to experience His presence and will empower us to overcome every fear. Isaiah 58:14 says, that those who obey God will feast on the inheritance of your father Jacob. The inheritance of their father Jacob is the promised land and God's presence for us. Let's commit our lives to this offer of abundant life, so that our generations will be saved, and we will be together with Him in eternity. For those who have known this love should declare this love by our life and testimony and by sharing this redemptive offer to the world that is so needy.
